Sam Rahman had a strong run for 16th in 17 mins 52 secs and Steve Philcox closed the scorers in 17 mins 59 secs in 21st winning the M50 group trophy.

The mens Ilford team won their second ELvIS match of the series as they remain in second spot in the league.


