Location Loughton Athletic Club ([www.loughtonac.org.uk/](http://www.loughtonac.org.uk/))

Limited parking available on nearby streets (Oakwood Hill, Roding Road South, River Way) so do try and come via Public Transport if you can. Loughton Tube station is ten minutes from the Club House.

The race distance will be ~8km/5m cross country. Ongoing changes to paths and gates over the bridge will lead to a few tweaks as ever but the course will be largely that used for our other 5m events.

Entry is £3 per runner - look for the bucket or clubs can pay for entrants .

Please ask Team Managers to complete the attached entrants list so we can plan for numbers. V40 and up in ten year bands please. Please return entries by 6pm Thursday 9th November. I am not around Friday so your assistance in getting them in is much appreciated. We have added the opportunity for people to declare they do not want to be included in photos where we are able.
