First home for the men was Samuel Crane in 3rd place with a time of 17:10, Josh Adler came in very soon after in 17:36 for 6th place and Chris King was in 9th and 2nd Senior Male with 17:46.

In 11th, 12th and 13th place respectively were Stephen Philcox 17:49, Malcolm Muir 17:59 and Berekhet Berakhy completing the scoring team also recording a time of 17:59. These 3 were also 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the M50 age category on the day.

With 6 runners in the top 13, all recording a sub 18 minute 5k, it truly was a great day at the office for llfords men, finishing 1st on the day and 2nd in the final league table

Leading the ladies home was Jordan Hinds, placing 5th female on the day in a time of 20:23. Jordan was backed up by Gemma Ellender in 11th place for 22:02, Leila Lauder in 12th place in 22:07, Carlie Qirem in 18th in 22:52, Breege Nordin in 20th in 23:47, which placed her first VF60, with Alison Sale completing the women's team of 6 coming home in 24:29 to claim 26th place.
